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Active Assailant Review Planning Considerations

Phase One

- Reviewing the ASPR TRACIE tool – most comprehensive document
- Leading the review process
 - Executive buy-in
- Engaging internal and external partners
- Documenting findings (strengths and opportunities for improvement)

Active Assailant Review Planning Considerations

Phase Two

- Develop Action Plan of Opportunities
- Policy development
- Education
- Leader meetings/training
- Drills
- Exercises
- After-action review

Active Assailant Review Planning Considerations

Regular Review

- Develop cycle to review and update planning considerations document (like EM Program Plan cycle)
- Develop regular training cycle
- Regular meetings with subject matter experts to determine trends related to active assailant planning (local public safety)
