Children and COVID-19

ASPR TRACIE recently worked with [ASPR's Pediatric Centers of Excellence](#) to help our stakeholders better understand how the COVID-19 pandemic was affecting children. Webinar panelists covered a variety of topics that can help healthcare providers and community leaders prepare for, recognize, and manage these effects.

Child Emotional and Social Effects

This webinar focused on the emotional and social effects of COVID-19 on children. Speakers discussed food and financial insecurity, racial disparities, the impact of social determinants on children's health, return to school and daycare, and alternate childcare.

Child Health and Wellness

Panelists in this webinar focused on child health and wellness and discussed resumption of routine care, missed immunizations, lead poisoning screening, sleep, and child neglect and abuse.

Impact of COVID-19 on Children with Special Healthcare Needs

This webinar focused on the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on children with special healthcare needs. Panelists discussed related programs, the impact of COVID-19 and social determinants on this population of children, behavioral health/ psychological effects, child neglect/abuse, and secondary disaster preparedness planning considerations.

The Effects of Secondary Disasters on Children

In this webinar, speakers covered how secondary disasters may affect children during the COVID-19 pandemic. Panelists discuss sheltering in place versus mass sheltering; family preparedness considerations; wildland fire preparedness and response; the potential impact associated with influenza; planning for pediatric surge; MISC; epidemiology, clinical features, laboratory findings and outpatient approach; and pharmacy and supply chain considerations.
