#### **BACKGROUND**

The WV Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management requires that each county conduct, document, and submit a **Threat and Hazards Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA)** as a focused, actionable tool for preparedness planning. The objectives of the THIRA are to: 1) help the county develop targets for Core Capabilities in the National Preparedness Goal, 2) assess current capacity for every capability, 3) identify resources needed to meet each target, and 4) develop a list of actions to help build and sustain capability. [Reference: *FY 2014 State Guidance for Completing Local Threat and Hazard Impact and Risk Assessment*, WVHSEM, March 2014]

As a critical component of county infrastructure, healthcare facilities need to define their specific vulnerabilities and provide related information on current capabilities/resources to their local emergency management agency. The Healthcare THIRA has been designed as a tool to provide this collaborative information to optimize preparedness planning and resource allocation for healthcare needs. It should be updated and submitted to emergency management by the designated date or more often if operations, conditions, and/or capabilities change at the healthcare facility.

### \*\*\*COMPLETING THE HEALTHCARE THIRA\*\*\*

### STEP 1 – **Identify Healthcare Vulnerabilities** (Chart 1)

List the threats and hazards identified in the facility's Hazard Vulnerability Assessment (HVA).

### STEP 2 – Describe the Most Likely Disaster Scenarios for the Healthcare Facility (Chart 2)

For each of the top 3 threats to the healthcare facility:

<u>Detail a scenario and convey potential impacts</u> to include: a) geography of the facility or campus, b) infrastructure/equipment, c) population (i.e. # and/or % of staff, patients, visitors, and other populations served or supported), and d) operational impacts.

List necessary resources (from sources outside of your healthcare facility)

This list should include plans, procedures and other guidance; administrative and operational personnel; equipment and other supplies; training and educational needs; exercises and other validation measures; and other resources needed to ensure viability and effective planning/response for this scenario.

<u>Describe recommended actions</u> needed to develop, expand, and/or sustain your facility's planning or response to this scenario. This would include coordinated efforts involving other response partners and coalition members.

#### STEP 3 – Save and Submit Your Healthcare THIRA

Save your completed THIRA form and rename the file (i.e., Boone Memorial THIRA 093014)

Provide copies of your facility's updated THIRA to your county emergency management agency, the Regional Coordinator for your WV Hospital Region, and the WV Hospital Association.
