

Ryan M. Hill, PhD is an incoming Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of Texas at San Antonio, starting Fall 2021 and Adjunct Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at Baylor College of Medicine. He received his Bachelor's degree from the University of Michigan in 2009 and his PhD in the Clinical Science of Child and Adolescent Psychology from Florida International University in 2016. His research focuses on the prevention of suicide-related behaviors among adolescent and emerging adult populations, with a special emphasis on integrating technology into suicide prevention to improve outcomes and ensure intervention fidelity. Dr. Hill also conducts work on early (or "upstream") suicide prevention models, examining theories of suicidal behavior, seeking to better understand the development of suicide behaviors during the adolescent years, and improving clinical training in suicide prevention using evidence-based approaches.
